



Explore

Miles of tracks through forest, heath, meadow and woodland and alongside rivers and lakes on foot or by bike.



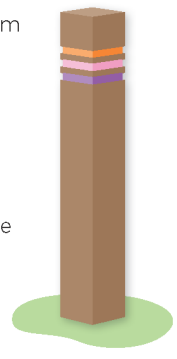
A more detailed map showing the walk and cycle trails is available to buy from the Visitor Centre for £1. Alternatively, follow the trails using the waymarked posts with coloured bands around the top. Most routes start from the totem pole 5.

Walking routes

- Lake and Riverside Walk - 0.75 miles / 1.2km
- Lookout Walk - 1.5 miles / 2.4km
- Park and Forest Walk - 3 miles / 4.8km
- Long Forest Walk - 5 miles / 8km

Family cycle routes

- Corsican Loop - Central 2 mile / 3.2km route
- Crane Loop - Adds 2 miles / 3.2km
- Somerley Loop - Adds 1 mile / 1.6km
- Watchmoor Loop - Adds 1.5 miles / 2.4km



Visitor Centre

Ask at the **Information Point** for Season Tickets, event bookings, first aid, lost property, Moors Valley souvenirs or if you require assistance from a ranger.

The rangers organise events throughout the year; ask at the Visitor Centre or visit moors-valley.co.uk for details.

Seasons Restaurant serve breakfast, lunches, snacks and drinks, as well as catering for children's parties and private functions. There is outdoor seating in the courtyard for restaurant customers.

Mountain bikes, trailers, tag-a-longs, children's bikes and mobility scooters are available to hire from the **Cycle Hire Centre** (deposit and ID required).

Toilets and baby changing facilities are available at the Visitor Centre and Kingsmere Station.
